# That Clause 7.2 and 7.4 of the Trust Deed shall be deleted and replaced with the following:

7.2 Subject to Clause 7.1 the management committee shall consist of:

7.2.1. 6 elected members7.2.2. 3 appointed membersand may include not more than7.2.3. 3 co-opted members

All such members of the management committee are charity trustees for the purposes of charity law.

#### 7.4 Appointed members

Whaddon Parish Council may appoint TWO members. St Marys Church may appoint ONE member. Currently The Trust Deed (our governing document), states that the management committee shall consist of:

4 elected members 5 appointed members And may include not more than 2 co-opted members.
